Board Passes New Water Management and Drought Contingency Plan

Recognizing the need to promote water conservation as part of the District's overall planning efforts, the Board of Directors passed a Water Management and Drought Contingency Plan at the April 16, 2013 meeting. You can view the complete plan at www.tcmud.org.

Conserving water doesn't just save money on the number of gallons you use. Conservation can help control costs by preserving infrastructure and reducing the need for additional water supplies. Allowing more time between infrastructure upgrades and updates also helps keep rates stable for District customers.

The new plan contains year-round restrictions on outdoor watering. This schedule will help stabilize demand, allow storage tanks time to refill, and prevent mechanical failures. **Unless the Drought Plan is activated, customers will be allowed to water three days per week as follows:**

- Odd addresses may water on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday.
- Even addresses may water on Wednesday, Friday and Sunday.
- NO irrigation is permitted on Monday.
- Watering with a sprinkler or irrigation system is prohibited any

day between 10:00 am and 6:00 pm.

- Watering with a soaker hose or drip irrigation is permitted at any time or day except on Monday.
- Watering with a hand-held hose or bucket can be done at any time or on any day.
 - If hydro mulch, grass sod, or grass seed is installed for the purpose of establishing a new lawn, there are no watering restrictions for the first 30 days while it is being established.



Violations of the new year-round restrictions are enforceable by the Trophy Club MUD No. 1. Section XI procedures include:

- Written warning for the first violation.
- \$50 administrative penalty on the next water bill for second and subsequent violations.
- Disconnection of service for a third violation, with a \$200 reconnection charge in addition to the \$50 administrative penalty. Reconnection will only be allowed during regular business hours.

ONGOING DROUGHT CONDITIONS—STAY IN TOUCH

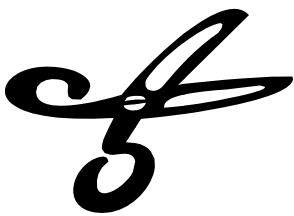

We can't predict when this will happen, but Stage 1 plans include a TWICE per week watering schedule.
